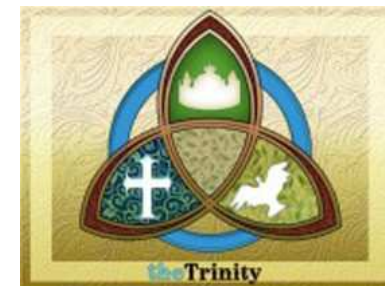

another as you have loved us.**

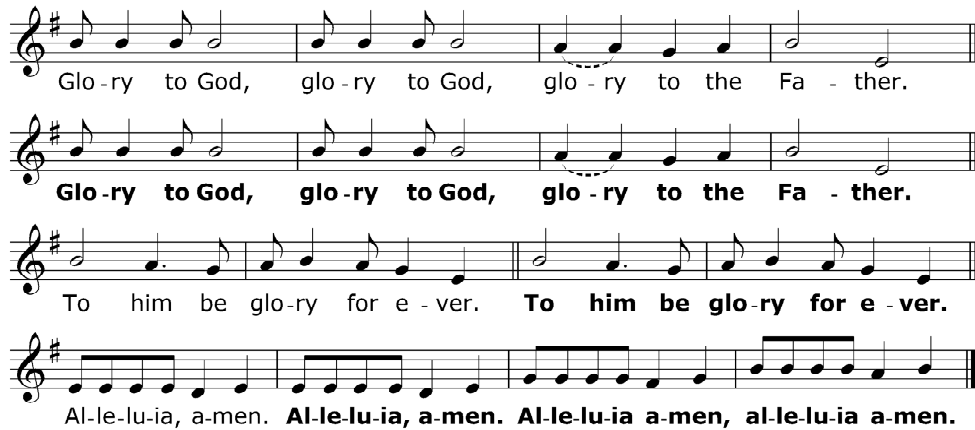
