PROCESSION & FAMILY COMMUNION



Please say the words in **bold type**

We begin our celebration of Palm Sunday with our own 'Procession into Jerusalem', waving palm branches, and led by a donkey, and singing our own hosannas.

Sing hosanna! Sing hosanna!
Sing hosanna to the King of kings!
Sing hosanna! Sing hosanna!
Sing hosanna to the King!

On reaching the church – and ideally remaining outside – we sing:

HYMN

Make way, make way,
for Christ the King in splendour arrives;
fling wide the gates and welcome Him
into your lives.

Make way, make way for the King of kings, for the King of kings. Make way, make way, and let his kingdom in.

He comes the broken hearts to heal, the pris'ners to free; the deaf shall hear, the lame shall dance, the blind shall see. Make way...

And those who mourn with heavy hearts, who weep and sigh, with laughter, joy and royal crown he'll beautify.

We call you now to worship him as Lord of all, to have no gods before him, their thrones must fall.

WELCOME AND NOTICES

INVITATION TO WORSHIP

Come close to God and he will come close to you.

O God our heavenly Father, in our worship help us to come near to you, to sing your praise, to confess our sins, to hear your word and to bring our prayers to you, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

CONFESSION (saying sorry to God - please sit or kneel)

The Lord is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and of great kindness. Let us tell God that we are sorry for our sins and ask him to forgive us.

For turning away from you and ignoring your will for our lives: Father forgive us.

Save us and help us.

For behaving just as we wish without thinking of you: Father forgive us.

Save us and help us.

For failing you by what we do and think and say: Father forgive us. Save us and help us.

For letting ourselves be drawn away from you by temptations in the world about us: Father forgive us.

Save us and help us.

For living as if we were ashamed to belong to your Son: Father forgive us.

Save us and help us.

May God our heavenly Father forgive us all the sins we have now confessed to him and help us to serve him better in the days to come. **Amen.**

THE COMMUNION (please sit or kneel)

The Lord be with you and also with you.

Lord of all life, you created the universe, where all living things reflect your glory. You give us this great and beautiful earth, to discover and to cherish.

You give us the fish in the sea, the birds of the air, and every plant and tree; the life that sleeps in the winter earth, and awakens again in the spring.

You made us all, each wonderfully different, to join with the angels and sing your praise:

Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest.

We thank you, loving Father, because, when we turned away, you sent Jesus, your Son.
He gave his life for us on the cross and shows us the way to live.

Send your Holy Spirit that these gifts of bread and wine may be for us Christ's body and his blood.

On the night before he died, when darkness had fallen, Jesus took bread.
He gave thanks, broke it, and shared it with his disciples, saying: 'This is my body, given for you. Do this to remember me.'

After they had eaten, he took the cup of wine, gave thanks, and shared it with his disciples, saying: 'This is my blood, poured out for you and for many, for the forgiveness of sins.'

So Father, with this bread and this cup we celebrate his love, his death, his risen life. As you feed us with these gifts, send your Holy Spirit, and change us more and more to be like Jesus our Saviour.

Help us, Father, to love one another, as we look forward to that day when suffering is ended, and all creation is gathered in your loving arms.

And now with all your saints we give you glory, through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Amen.

The Lord's Prayer

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. Everyone is welcome at the altar – to receive either the bread and wine or a blessing. If you wish to receive a blessing, please keep your hands below the rail.

After the choir motet, we all sing (from the music of the Taizé community):

O Lord, hear my prayer, O Lord, hear my prayer: when I call, answer me. O Lord, hear my prayer, O Lord, hear my prayer. Come and listen to me.

After Communion we pray:

Almighty God

We thank you for feeding us with the body and blood of your Son Jesus Christ. Through him we offer you our souls and bodies
To be a living sacrifice.
Send us out in the power of your Spirit
To live and work to your praise and glory. Amen.
