THE COMMUNION

(please sit or kneel)

The Lord is here.

His Spirit is with us.

Lift up your hearts.

We lift them to the Lord.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

It is right to give thanks and praise.

It is right to praise you, Father, Lord of all creation; in your love you made us for yourself. When we turned away you did not reject us, but came to meet us in your Son.

You embraced us as your children and welcomed us to sit and eat with you.

In Christ you shared our life that we might live in him and he in us.

He opened wide his arms of love upon the cross and made for all the perfect sacrifice for sin.

On the night he was betrayed, at supper with friends, he took bread and gave you thanks. He broke it and gave it to them, saying: take, eat; this is my body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.

Father we do this in remembrance of him; his body is the bread of life.

At the end of supper, taking the cup of wine, he gave you thanks and said; drink this all of you; this is my blood of the new covenant, which is shed for you for the forgiveness of sins. Do this in remembrance of me.

Father, we do this in remembrance of him; his blood is shed for all.

As we proclaim his death and celebrate his rising in glory, send your Holy Spirit that this bread and this wine may be to us the body and blood of your dear Son.

As we eat and drink these holy gifts make us one in Christ our risen Lord.

With the whole Church throughout the world we offer you this sacrifice of praise and lift our voice to join the eternal song of heaven:

Holy, holy, holy Lord God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory.

Hosanna in the highest.

Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.

THE LORD'S PRAYER

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.

Please come to the altar to receive either the bread and wine or God's blessing.

If you wish to receive a blessing please keep your hands below the rail.

Almighty God, we thank you for feeding us with the body and blood of your Son Jesus Christ. Through him we offer you our souls and bodies to be a living sacrifice. Send us out in the power of your Spirit, to live and work to your praise and glory. Amen.
