CONFESSION

... saying sorry to God (please sit or kneel)

The Lord is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and of great kindness. Let us tell God that we are sorry for our sins and ask him to forgive us.

For turning away from you
and ignoring your will for our lives:
Father forgive us. **Save us and help us.**

For behaving just as we wish
without thinking of you:
Father forgive us. **Save us and help us.**

For failing you by what we do
and think and say:
Father forgive us. **Save us and help us.**

For letting ourselves be drawn away from you
by temptations in the world about us:
Father forgive us. **Save us and help us.**

For living as if we were ashamed
to belong to your Son:
Father forgive us. **Save us and help us.**

May God our heavenly Father forgive us all the sins we have now confessed to him and help us to serve him better in the days to come. **Amen.**

As you feed us with these gifts,
send your Holy Spirit,
and change us more and more
to be like Jesus our Saviour.

Help us, Father, to love one another,
as we look forward to that day
when suffering is ended,
and all creation is gathered in your loving arms.
And now with all your saints
we give you glory,
through Jesus Christ our Lord.
